APC01 Server, Ethernet cable (CAT 5), mains power supply 230V, operating instruction

Intended Use

Use the APC01 Control Center only to control Easywave, Easywave neo or secwave radio transmitters and radio receivers.

The manufacturer shall not be liable for any damage caused by improper or non-intended use!

Safety Advice

Carefully read through these instructions before connecting and operating the unit!

Observe the applicable laws, standards and regulations as well as the manufacturer's instructions for the devices to be operated.

Do not make any unauthorized alterations or modifications to the unit!

Have faulty units checked by the manufacturer!

Function

The Easywave Control Center represents the command base of an Easywave building installation.

The integrated wireless module allows Easywave, Easywave neo and secwave devices to be controlled using an Android or Apple smartphone or tablet.

Functions include:

- Creating scenes
- Scheduled execution of switching commands
- Logical linking of sensors and actuators
- Astro function
- Push notifications
- Integration with Alexa
- Weather data as triggers for scenes
- Remote access

The configuration of individual functions is detailed in the app with help texts.

Some functions may be subject цЦ to charges!

Manage up to 128 devices depending on the telegram type (Easywave, Easywave neo or secwave).

Setting up

1. Connect the Control Center

Connect the plug-in power adaptor with the server and then plug the power adaptor into a 230V socket.

The server will be ready for operation after approx. 30 seconds.

2. Establish connection between Control Center and home network

Connect the server to the local network or the network port of your router using a network cable. Ensure that the DHCP function of the router is enabled. Once the network connection is successfully established, the LED lights up green. Then proceed with the next steps.

3. Commission radio transmitters and receivers

Read the operating instructions of the used radio transmitters or receivers.

4. Start Easywave CCapp

Download and install the "Easywave CCapp" from the App Store. Connect the smartphone/ tablet via WI AN to the same network as the APC01. Start the "Easywave CCapp" on the smartphone/tablet. Follow the instructions in the app for the initial commissioning of the server by creating the owner account and first rooms.

Generate QR code 5.

Generate a QR code and save it in a secure place. The QR code is needed to reset the password if necessary.

6. Program Control Center

Create rooms, devices, and scenes and link them with the desired radio products. Follow the instructions in the app.

WLAN Configuration

If an internet connection via Ethernet cable is not possible, the APC01 can also be integrated into an existing WLAN network. For the setup, the server provides a Bluetooth connection for the first 10 minutes after switching on (blue LED blinks). Ensure that Bluetooth is also enabled on your smartphone/tablet and that the Easywave app has the necessary permissions. Note that the app also needs access to the location to establish a Bluetooth connection.

The Bluetooth range is significantly shorter цŲ than that of the Easywave radio system. Therefore, perform the configuration in close proximity to the server!

To configure, proceed as follows:

- 1. Disconnect the APC01 from the power supply for about 10 seconds.
- Restore the power supply. Wait until the LED 2. on the APC01 blinks blue.
- 3. Start the Easywave app and click on "Start initial setup" or the "Add server" button (+).
- After the app unsuccessfully searches for a 4. server, click on "Configure WLAN server".
- The app now searches for a server via 5. Bluetooth. Select the desired server and the WI AN to be used
- The SSID of the WLAN to be used must be set to "visible" for this time!
- Enter the password of the selected WLAN 6 network, the server then connects to the WLAN network and can be used in the network.
- Once the APC01 is connected to a network via LAN, the Bluetooth/WLAN connection is automatically deactivated!

Start the WLAN configuration mode manually if necessary by briefly pressing the reset button (see "Reset button").



The APC can only be connected to one network at a time, either via LAN or

LED Signaling

The RGB LED on the top of the APC01 indicates the current operating status. The displayed color codes have the following meanings:

Color code LED	Action
LED flashes white	Boot process is running
LED lights up green	Operating mode active
LED flashes red	Error in the device / system
LED lights up yellow	Searching for update
LED flashes yellow	Update is being installed
LED flashes blue	Searching for network, Bluetooth configuration active
LED lights up blue	Network is being configured

Reset Password

User Accounts

Each user of the APC01 server must log in to the server with a name and password.

The owner of the server can create any number of accounts. Admin rights can optionally be assigned to each account.

If a password is lost, it can be reassigned by another user with admin rights.

If the passwords of all admin accounts are lost, only the password reset by the owner account remains.



The password can only be reset if the smartphone and server are in the same local network!

A password reset via remote connection is not possible!

Owner Accounts

The first user created during the initial setup is the so-called "owner" of the system. This account is highlighted with a key symbol in the user overview. This account cannot be deleted. The password of the owner account can be reset either by an existing QR code or by a verified email address.

Click on the "Forgot password" link after an unsuccessful login attempt. Then you can choose one of the two options to restore the password.



If neither QR code nor a verified email address is available, only the complete factory reset of the server remains! (see "Reset button").

QR Code

Only the owner of the system can generate a QR code to reset their own password. The app automatically prompts to generate a QR code during the initial setup.



We strongly recommend generating a QR code during the initial setup and saving it in a secure place!

To reset the password, simply scan the QR code with the smartphone camera when prompted by the app. Then you can set a new password. A new "owner code" can be generated at any time by the owner account via "Settings" if the previous QR code is lost. Once a new QR code is generated, the previous QR code becomes invalid!

Email Verification

During the initial setup, an email address of the owner can be stored in the app. This email address is then verified by sending and entering a code.

Once the verification is successfully completed, you can also reset the owner password this way. The owner can request an email with a reset code via the "Forgot password" function. This code must then be entered in the corresponding input field in the app.



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Do not close the input window until you have entered the code! Otherwise, a new code must be requested!

The email address and subsequent verification can be added or changed at any time in the user settings of the owner account under the "Advanced" menu item.

A successfully verified email address is indicated by a checkmark next to the corresponding input field.

We strongly recommend verifying a valid email address!

Reset Button

The reset button is located next to the power supply and can be operated, for example, with a paperclip.

Hold the reset button for the specified time to trigger the following functions:

1 second \rightarrow LED turns blue Start WLAN configuration mode (LED blinks blue)

3 seconds \rightarrow LED turns white \rightarrow restart The server is restarting.

10 seconds \rightarrow LED turns red \rightarrow factory reset All settings are deleted.

15 seconds \rightarrow LED goes out

Server restarts without other special functions.

Troubleshooting

A radio receiver does not respond:

- Check the installation location for an unobstructed radio connection between the server and the radio receiver.
- Reprogram the transmission code into the receiver if necessary.
- There may be interference from other radio products using the same frequency and operating in close proximity.

The server does not respond to radio transmitters:

- Ensure that the server is within range of the transmitter.
- Replace the batteries of the transmitter if necessarv
